3. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PAST MEETINGS** – Approved
4. **AGENDA ITEMS**
 - **Stakeholder/Science Team Updates**
 - **Stakeholder Committee** – Met September 20
 - Approved Annual Report
 - Will review chloride Task Force findings and make recommendations on implementation
 - Dr. Argerich’s masters student spoke about what has been learned from the synoptic sampling with respect to the longevity/fate of nitrogen in the stream.
 - Michele presented Chloride Task Force findings.
 - Stakeholders approved the logo design contest.
 - **Science Team** – Met October 3
 - Rob Jacobson is still involved in the Science Team, representing MU.
 - The team wants Chloride Task Force members to come to a meeting and discuss integrating their recommendations with the Science Strategy.
 - Lynne will compile a summary of studies that have been done on the Science Team’s recommendation.
 - DNR is working on some flood mapping, and Hinkson was proposed within DNR. (Lynne to look into this – Hinkson flood maps were revised in 2017.)

 - Dr. Alvarez is reviewing data now.
 - **Synoptic Sampling**
 - Grad student will have paper regarding results ready next spring.
 - **Status of Conductivity Study Agreement**
 - Contract to get 1st and 2nd reading at County Commission the week of October 23.
 - **CAM Website Redesign**
 - Stakeholders approved logo design contest.
 - Michele got guidance for the contest from City Office of Cultural Affairs.
 - The City does this fairly often—might be best for them to host the competition
 - Will try for a design concept that can be used in various ways rather than a final design for the logo.

- **Regulatory Updates**
 - Still some activity on PFAS – expect drinking water will be regulated first.
 - DNR’s MS4 coordinator went new maps of urban areas.
 - Census is no longer preparing the maps.
 - EPA creates the mapping now from census data.
 - DNR had meetings regarding a final rule for Phosphorous, nutrient trading and a triennial meeting regarding selenium.
 - Meeting is scheduled to work on rule making for Bacteria and Pathogens.
