Stakeholder/Science Team Updates

- Stakeholder Committee last met December 20th
 - New EPA facilitator Jessica Atkisson
 - Stakeholders ranked their priorities of Chloride Task Force recommendations
 - Ms Hardt has never attended a meeting; Rob Wolverton has only been to one
- Science Team Met December 5
 - Robert Voss has set up a repository for Science Team documents
 - Mr. Voss is also going to do a first draft of the revised Science Strategy
 - Expressed some interest in an all-teams meeting
 - March/April might be a good target time-frame
 - Try to have study reports available for presentation by then
 - The Science Team would like to see whatever information the MS4 partners have about BMPs that have been installed in their jurisdictions
- Riparian Subcommittee Met January 8
 - Hinkson stabilization site might be a good one instead
 - County working with City Sustainability and others to do a neighborhood-focused spring Riparian Workshop
 - Considering a property in East Campus away from the main stream
 - May go to Capen Park for some in-stream activities
 - Ted to check and see when culvert replacement is expected on Capen Dr and how long the work will last.

Action Updates/Proposals

- USGS Chemical Sampling
 - Lynne received some more of the data.
 - Still working on the payment problem.
- Synoptic Sampling
 - No update. Expect something around graduation.
 - Remove from agenda until March or April
- Conductivity Study

- Josh Horne with Geosyntec presented some early results of stream flow, conductivity and temperature at a few locations.
- Specific conductance jumped during first runoff event at I-70 and Hinkson, and at Flat Branch

CAM Website Redesign

- No news
- Tree Planting Day at Alspaugh park for CAM participants
 - Discussed a field day involving all teams to plant trees and/or remove invasives in a riparian area.
 - Could try for spring but fall plantings usually work best
 - Tom to follow up with Parks to see if Alspaugh tract would be okay and if they are interested.

• Shifting riparian restoration effort from Battle to another location

- Tom to work out with City Staff
- Next Steps
 - Nothing new
- Regulatory Updates
 - Recent DNR Water Quality Triennial Review recommended
 - No rule making for cobalt
 - Pausing development of WQ standard for Cadmium
 - Aluminum still under review
 - Missouri House of Representatives is working on Waters of the State rule
 - Seem to be leaning toward making adjacency a determining factor-similar to the US Supreme Court ruling in Sackett vs EPA

Announcements/Comments

- City is in the process of revising the Sewer and Stormwater Integrated Management Plan
 - HDR Consulting will work on it
 - Several months away from possible changes
