#### USGS Chemical Sampling

#### • Hinkson Stream Stabilization near Clear Creek Force Main

- City acquired necessary Corps and Water Quality permits.
- City in process of hiring and engineer to do the flood study to verify no-rise.
- Speaking with Term and Supply Contractors about doing the work in April.
- Next Steps No new actions proposed.

### Regulatory Updates

- MoDNR is beginning Nutrient Rulemaking Process for WWTPs and Major Industrial Operations
  - Proposing limit of 1mg/L for Phosphorous
  - 5 years to come into compliance
- RFP for 319 Grants is out w/ application deadline of April 1.
