The meeting was called to order at approximately 4:00 p.m.

Minutes from the November 17, 2009 meeting were approved.

In reviewing; some members believed the summary is too long to be in the implementation chapter and that the summary should come at the end the chapter

The group agreed that the vision should be included in Chapter 1 and that the TMDL should be moved to another chapter. Recommendations were discussed and it was agreed among members to prioritize the list of recommendations and state why each is important. Bill Florea suggested the committee give recommendations and not solutions because some solutions may not be feasible. The group should state the goal and perhaps recommend ways to achieve these goals.

Bill Florea stated we have to have load reduction as part of the plan. The question is where do we get better information? The group discussed ways to get more information.

The group discussed how specific the recommendations should be.

Todd Houts recommended a new section; to monitor the effectiveness by specifically putting in the long term maintenance of the five monitoring stations that are already in place at the watershed to make sure that those stations stay intact and functioning. The group decided this should go under recommendations.

Bill Florea stated he would reformat and add more intent why we want to do some of these things and check numbers on practices.

The group asked about removing the numbers from the plan. Mr. Florea stated there has to be load reduction numbers in the plan per the EPA.
