A Public Hearing will be held at the second council meeting in August. Kori Thompson stated that the City is looking at getting video/photographs of the site for a future PSA video.

- USDA RCPP Program
 - The group discussed the use of the RCPP funding program. The RCPP program requires a two-phase application and evaluation process that includes a pre-proposal application in April and a full proposal (if selected) in August. The application cycle for FY2018 is already underway. Any participation in the program would come in FY2019 or later. The RCPP program encourages partnerships and requires a match of the program funds. Potential partners were discussed including Boone Electric, Water & Light, and the University. Lynne Hooper stated that she would contact the Missouri Department of Conservation to determine their interest as a potential partner. Kori Thompson stated that she would contact the State Conservationist to set up a meeting to discuss the potential use of the RCPP Program. Mike Powell, Lynne Hooper, Bill Florea, and Paul Mehrle would like to attend the meeting.
